Celebrations involve public parades and festivals, ceilithe, and the wearing of green attire or shamrocks.

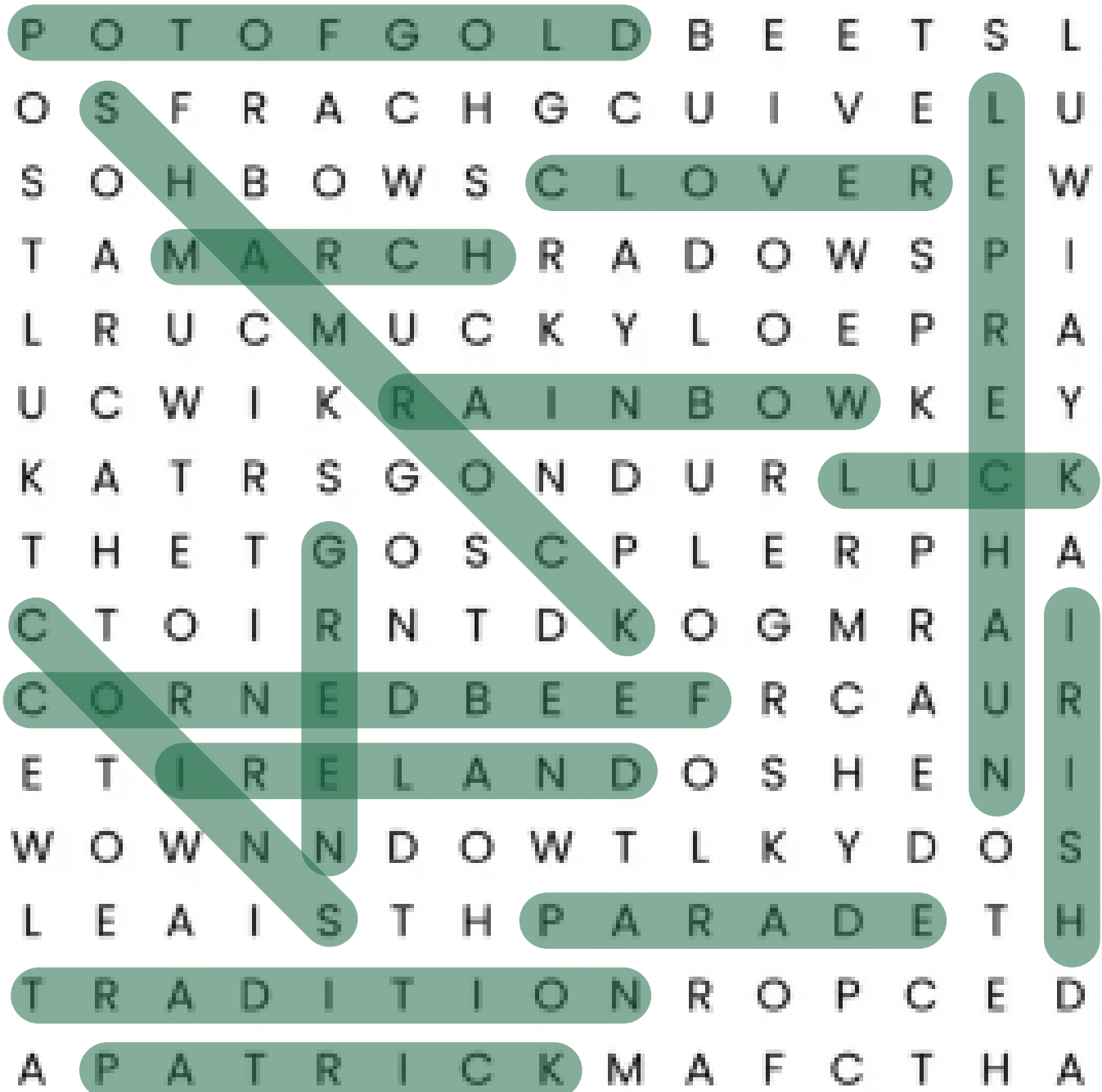
